

COVID-19 SAFETY CHECKLIST

MARTIAL ARTS REOPENING CONSIDERATIONS

The following lists the operational adjustments that martial arts studios may want to consider as they reopen during the COVID-19 pandemic. It is important to note that many of these considerations may change as government guidelines, industry standards and guidance from medical professionals evolve. As you develop your reopening plans, it is critical that you ensure that they are compliant with federal, state and local laws and government regulations. Additionally, it is always a good idea to review your plans with your legal counsel.

ADMITTANCE PROTOCOLS				
1	Consider conducting daily temperature checks for members and instructors prior to allowing them entrance into the facility. No touch infrared thermometers can be purchased at a reasonable cost and is an effective way to ensure individuals inside your facility do not have a fever. Additionally, anyone exhibiting cold or flu like symptoms should not be allowed into the facility.	Yes No N/A		
2	Consider having members and instructors complete a Travel Declaration and COVID-19 form. Note: Individuals that have traveled overseas, or even to "hot-spot" areas in the United States, as well as individuals who have been in contact with an individual affected by the COVID-19 virus, should be subject to a 14-day self-quarantine prior to being allowed to enter the facility. 3	Develop a written sick policy. Members and instructors should be symptom free for at least 14 days prior to entering the facility.	Yes No N/A		
4	Consider having members and instructors complete medical questionnaires. Individuals with preexisting medical conditions should be discouraged not to participate.	Yes No N/A		
5	Post signage at or near the entrance areas informing patrons of the facility's policies, procedures, and guest code of conduct relative to COVID-19.	Yes No N/A		
6	Develop attendance or log-in procedures for all individuals present and maintain that information for potential contact tracing.	Yes No N/A

1	Consider creative options to modify close-contact drills to avoid person to person contact. Note: This may difficult for many martial art styles like Brazilian jiu jitsu that involves grappling, sparring and submission techniques that require another person to practice with. Grappling dummies might be a short-term alternative to live partner drills. Martial art studios should consult with their state and/or local health departments for guidance.	Yes No N/A		
2	Consider drills that don't require hands on spotting by the instructor. Note: Spotting, the physical contact between an instructor and a student, is essential in both skill development and safety in martial arts.
