SAFE DRIVING CHECKLIST		
1	Allow only authorized employees to drive the cars. Authorized drivers should be currently licensed drivers.	Yes No No N/A
2	Drivers and passengers must remain seated while the vehicle is moving.	Yes No No N/A
3	Never exceed the number of available seats for the number of passengers.	Yes No No N/A
4	Vehicles with rear facing seats should have seat belts or a guardrail.	Yes No No N/A
5	Consider using only vehicles with front-facing seats as cars with rear facing seats pose a higher risk of falls.	Yes No No N/A
6	The driver should complete a visual confirmation to ensure everyone is seated before driving.	Yes No No N/A
7	Slow down and honk the horn at all intersections.	Yes No N/A
8	Reduce speed when approaching pedestrians, who always have the right of way.	Yes No No N/A
9	Use the safety mirrors at each intersection to ensure pedestrian safety. In fact, venues should install parabolic mirrors at all intersections or corners throughout the lower level concourses to reduce blind spots	Yes No No N/A
10	Reduce speed when turning or passing through door ways.	Yes No No N/A
11	Do not park vehicles where they will block emergency equipment, pedestrian aisles, doorways, intersections, or the normal traffic flow.	Yes No No N/A
12	Vehicles should be operated at a speed equivalent to a well-paced walk, and no faster than 15 MPH.	Yes No No N/A
13	The actual speed of a Golf Cart depends upon the terrain over which it is being driven, the weather conditions, and the total weight of the Golf Cart, passengers and any equipment being carried.	Yes No No N/A
